This year, National Crime Victims' Rights Week is April 13<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup>. Under the leadership of Supervisor Scott Haggerty, President of the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, a proclamation has been issued declaring this week "Victims' Rights' Week" in Alameda County.

This year's theme "***Justice for Victims, Justice for all***" aims to remind us that crime can strike ***anyone***, and because of this ***every*** citizen has a powerful stake in victim's rights.

This year's event, which is being co-sponsored by B.A.W.A.R., the Oakland Police Department, **the Alameda County Family Justice Center**, and **the Alameda County District Attorney's Office Victim /Witness Assistance Division**, will be held on ***Friday, April 18, 2008, at Oakland City Hall, 1 Frank Ogawa Plaza from 10:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.*** There will be a special exhibit by B.A.W.A.R.'s "Soles of Survivors" throughout the day; other community organizations will be on site to provide information and resources; finally at noon we will have guest speakers and a young adult gospel choir "*His People*" will perform.

**The District Attorney's Office** will have information booths at additional locations throughout the County to distribute information about our services and to provide assistance with filling out victims of crime applications. At this time, those locations will be:
